Items of discussion per Ind. Code 5-14-1.5-6.1

- (1) For discussion of strategy with respect to any of the following: Collective Bargaining. Initiation of litigation or litigation that is either pending or has been threatened specifically in writing. The implementation of security systems. The purchase or lease of real property by the governing body up to the time a contract or option to purchase or lease is executed by the parties.
- (2) For discussion of the assessment, design, and implementation of school safety and security measures, plans, and systems.
- (3) Interviews and negotiations with industrial or commercial prospects.
- (4) To receive information about and interview prospective employees.
- (5) With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction.
- (6) For discussion of records classified as confidential by state or federal statute.
- (7) Where authorized by federal or state statute.
- (8) To discuss before a placement decision an individual student's abilities, past performances, behavior, and needs.
- (9) To discuss job performance evaluation of individual employees.
- (10) To train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of the role of members as public officials.
- (11) To discuss information and intelligence intended to prevent, mitigate, or respond to the threat of terrorism.
