Local Scholarship Programs

Sullivan County High Schools Ag Day Scholarship (\$2500). Essay, "How does weed resistance and chemical controls affect today's farmers in their production and business decisions- 800-1200 words. Due February 12, 2018. Must include cover sheet with name, address, telephone number, and email. Do not write name on the essay page. Send entries to: Courtney Schmidt, Extension Educator, 1361 E Co. Rd. 75 N Sullivan, IN 47882. *Deadline March 10th.*

Ceres Solutions (\$1,000). Students who have parents or grandparents who are a member of the Cooperative. Please see Mrs. Catlin for the application.

WIN Energy Scholarship Program. Students must have parent/guardian who are WIN Energy REMC member. Student must have a C average or above. Please pick up an application from Mrs. Catlin or fill it out at WIN Energy REMC online. *Deadline is February 16th at 4:30pm.*

Indiana Daughters of the Revolution Scholarship (\$500 at minimum). Students must plan to attend an Indiana Institution and must receive a letter of sponsorship from their local DAR chapter (Cynthia Fredrick 429 West Jefferson Ave. Vincennes, IN 47591/ 812-726-5384/cynthialfredrick@hotmail.com). Please pick up the application from Mrs. Catlin. *Deadline is March 1st.*

National Daughters of the Revolution (amounts vary). Students must fill out application and the information will be applied to their scholarship pool. Students must write a statement of 1,000 or less stating their career objectives and have at least 2 letters of recommendation. Students need a list of extra-curricular activities, honors received, scholastic achievements, a copy of birth certificate, and application which you can pick up from Mrs. Catlin. *Deadline is February 15th at midnight.*

Wabash Valley Herb Society (\$1000). Students who are pursuing careers related to herbs such as, medicine, journalism, culinary arts, restaurant management, agriculture, nutrition, pharmacy, etc. Please see Mrs. Catlin for the application. *Deadline is February 28th.*
